- Carlo A. Gemignani is an associate professor at the University of Parma in the Department of Humanities, Social Sciences and Cultural Industries (DUSIC).
- He has held scientific and teaching positions at the Universities of Genoa, Turin, and Trento.
- His work focuses on geography concerning the conservation and enhancement of cultural and environmental heritage; the history of the territory, with a particular focus on the inland Apennine areas; cartography and photography applied to the diachronic analysis of the landscape; the history of travel, tourism, and geographical representations; and the history of geographical thought and geography.
- He is a member of the coordinating committee of the Italian Center for Historical-Geographical Studies (CISGE), the scientific committee of the Alcide Cervi Institute/Emilio Sereni Library-Archive (Gattatico, RE), and is a member of the Institute for the History of the Italian Risorgimento, Parma territorial committee.
